Brief Introduction to the Tourist Spots

Udo



Udo Island (우도), or "Cow Island," is a scenic, volcanic offshore island. Its name originates from its unique shape—when viewed from above, the entire island resembles a lazy cow lying quietly by the sea, which has become one of its most distinctive symbols. Known for its fertile soil, white coral beaches, stunning emerald waters, and unique peanut-based treats, it offers a relaxing, rural getaway representing a "miniature Jeju".



Seongsan Ilchulbong

Seongsan Ilchulbong, or "Sunrise Peak," is a 182-meter high UNESCO World Heritage site on Jeju Island's eastern coast, formed by an underwater eruption over 5,000 years ago. It is renowned for its dramatic bowl-shaped crater, lush green scenery, and breathtaking sunrise views.



Sopjikoji

Seopjikoji is a stunning, free-access coastal cape on the eastern shore of Jeju Island, famous for its dramatic volcanic cliffs, vast canola flower fields in spring, and iconic white lighthouse. Located in Seogwipo, it is a premier spot for scenic ocean views and has served as a filming site for many Korean dramas.



JEJU Dongmun Market

JEJU Dongmun Market, established in 1945, is Jeju Island's largest and oldest permanent market. Located in Jeju City, it is a bustling hub for local produce, fresh seafood (especially raw fish), and souvenirs. It features a popular night market with food trucks and is known for its energetic atmosphere and affordable, authentic Jeju food.
